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Dear White Lake Golf Club Members,

As we anticipate the **97th** year of playing golf at White Lake Golf Club in 2013, we are very grateful and thankful for the continued support of our 304 members. It is very evident that our membership loves golf and loves playing our historic and well-conditioned golf course. Furthermore, the engagement of the many circles of golfing friends at White Lake Golf Club is a testament to the vitality of our club. White Lake Golf Club members played 13,000 rounds of golf in 2012 which included casual play as well as the opportunity to participate in as many as 40 competitive events that were scheduled throughout the golfing season!!

2013 Membership Campaign

As most of you know, this past fall, the WLGC Board launched an aggressive membership retention and recruitment campaign for 2013. The 2012 survey results showed that most members did not feel that the Green/Gold Cards were an incentive to recruit new members. With this in mind, our new membership campaign offers greater discounts for "groups" of people that join at once. (Please refer to the attached chart for pricing.) Our premise is that members will play where their friends play. The tighter the group of golfing "buddies" the more likely they will continue to play together. Instead of the Green/Gold Cards incentive, sponsoring members will receive \$150 for each new member they recruit and an additional \$100 in 2014 if the new member renews again in 2014! Sponsoring members will receive their dues reductions as a cash rebate in June, 2013. This 2013 Membership Recruitment/Retention Campaign was launched based on the fact that since 2004 our membership has declined from 350 members to 304 in 2012. This reduction in memberships for the past eight years equals to about \$65,000 in lost revenue per year. Although we continue to be debt free, the additional memberships will allow us to generate funds needed for timely equipment replacement and dealing with increased energy costs.

Conservation

The WLGC Board of Directors has worked diligently over this past year meeting and deliberating on a number of opportunities and issues that will serve the WLGC in the years to come. The Board is constantly working with staff to find ways to increase revenue and reduce operating expenses. In addition to the 2013 Membership Recruitment/Retention Campaign, the Board has taken the following actions with regard to conserving funds:

- Postpone purchasing of new equipment
- Working with Consumers Energy to consolidate and conserve energy usage
- Layoffs of full time employees during winter months

 None of these actions will have a detrimental affect on the quality of club
 service or on the conditioning of our course. We are confident that these
 actions will serve us well this year and will pay us dividends in the years to
 come.

Golf Course Improvements

Our Greens Chairman, Bill Benedict, has implemented some improvements to our golf course this past season, with a few more to come in 2013. I am sure you have noticed the removal of some trees on holes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 16 and 17 and the removal of sand traps on holes 11 and 14. Most of the trees were removed to increase sunlight and eliminate root encroachment around the greens and some were removed to enhance esthetics and approach. One tree was removed by the gold tee on #9 to open up the teeing zone. The sand traps were removed due to the difficulty of maintenance caused by water level saturation. The traps were replaced with grass berms.

This winter the trimming of low hanging branches will take place throughout the course, and in the spring, we will elevate and level #1 tee and install a new cart path serving the red tee on #9.

Also, many thanks to Bill Benedict for personally building the new benches that adorn the tees throughout our golf course!!

Finally, if you have a range finder, you probably noticed right away that we now have "crystals" on our pins that enhance distance accuracy when using range finders on the course.

Evan McCombs Memorial Practice Facility

We are extremely grateful to Rick McCombs, his wife Katrina Veerhusen, and their daughter Claire for their significant gift that has launched the construction of the Evan McCombs Memorial Practice Facility. We are also very appreciative to those WLGC members who have made additional contributions to the practice facility. These additional contributions support the completion of the irrigation system and the construction of a pavilion. Indeed, as I am writing this letter, bulldozers and backhoes are at work clearing stumps and roots in preparation for installing the irrigation system, contouring the tee, and, subsequent grass planting next summer!

Milestone

It was very sad to hear that the 116 year old Michillinda Lodge was completely destroyed by fire on December 2nd. White Lake Golf Club enjoyed a wonderful partnership with Michillinda where many luncheons and dinners were hosted for the WLGC Ladies Association, as well as the Men's Morning Group and the Wolverine Seniors. We are all hopeful that the lodge and restaurant will be rebuilt and continue to be vibrant partner with our golf club.

The first one is on Saturday, June 15th at 1:00 PM and the second one is scheduled for Wednesday, August 7th at 4:00 PM.
