

By-Laws of WLG CWA

Article I The name of the Association is White Lake Golf Club Women's Association.

Article II The purpose of the Association is to have fun and fellowship, promote women's golf, and organize events for the season.

Article III Membership:
Any woman golfer of the White Lake Golf Club may become a Member of the WLG CWA by paying dues at any time.

Article IV Officers:

- Chair
- Co-chair
- Secretary
- Treasurer

Officers are to be elected at the Annual Fall meeting. The members of the Executive Committee will present the slate of officers.

The Chair shall be elected for a one-year term with the option of Being re-elected to successive terms.

The Co-Chair shall be elected with the understanding that she will succeed the incumbent Chair.

The Secretary and Treasurer shall be elected to a two year-year term, with the option of being re-elected to successive terms. When possible these positions should be filled in alternate years to give continuity to these offices. An attempt will be made to have one of these positions filled by an 18-hole member and the other by a 9-hole member.

The 9-hole players shall appoint or elect a Chair and Co-Chair to represent their group and plan events for the season.

Article V Meetings:

- (1) Spring meeting will be the first Tuesday in June
The Secretary will send Notices, in April, to all active members.
- (2) Annual Fall Meeting will be the First Tuesday after Labor Day:
Club Champions prizes shall be awarded.
Officers shall be elected.
Old/and or new business shall be discussed and voted upon as needed.
The elected officers will assume responsibilities after the Fall meeting.
- (3) A special meeting may be called, at any time, at the discretion of the Chair. Time and place of the meeting, including the purpose of the meeting, shall be posted in the locker room not less than one week prior to the meeting.

Article VI Executive Committee

The Executive Committee shall consist of the Chair, Co-Chair, Secretary, Treasurer, Chair and Co-Chair of the 9-hole players, and the immediate Past-Chair.

The Executive Committee will choose another member to fill any vacancy of the Executive Committee which may occur.

Article VII Duties of Officers:

- Chair: Preside over all meetings, call Executive Committee meetings, act as spokesperson for the Executive Committee and Association, appoint committees as necessary, plan Tuesday events and Club Tournaments
- Co-Chair: Be an assistant to the Chair and perform duties of the Chair in her absence.

Secretary: Keep minutes of all meetings, issue notices, generate correspondence, and keep an up to date list of members with addresses and telephone numbers.

Treasurer: Collect and disburse all funds of the Association, keep funds in local bank in Association name, and provide the list of dues paying members to the secretary.

Two members of the Association shall audit the Treasurer's books. In addition to the Treasurer, the Secretary shall be empowered to sign checks for the Association for payment of bills.

Article VIII Amendment of By-laws:

By-laws may be amended, upon notice, at the Annual Fall meeting of the organization, by a majority of the members of the organization qualified to vote and present at the meeting.

Article IX Switching Divisions:

The WLGCA shall allow a member to move from one group to another before the first meeting of the year. Any additional requests past this date to change groups will be considered on a case by case basis by the Executive Committee.

Article X Hole-In-One Club "Payouts"

Any WLGCA member who is a paid \$5.00 member of our Hole-In-One Club who has a Hole-In-One during our weekly events will receive \$100 from the WLGCA. Prize to be paid out at any WLGCA weekly league play. We will include a HIO carry over balance to cap at \$300 per year.

- a) If depleted by one or more HIOs, there may be a need to be an assessment/rejoining at such time.
- b) If a HIO member retires/lapses from the WLGCWA membership for one season or more, they will need to re-join the HIO club with payment of current HIO dues.

Article XI Maximum Handicaps for Each Division
9 holers will be allowed 20 strokes for 9 holes.
18 holers will be allowed 40 strokes for 18 holes.

Article XII Maximum Strokes Allowed Per Hole.
During our weekly events, the maximum number of strokes that a player may take is 10.

Article XIII To allow divisional Crossover teams for the Member/Member event with a 10-stroke maximum difference based on the lowest handicap and the choice of playing in either the 9-hole or 18-hole division.

Article XIV To be eligible for the Most Improved award at the Fall meeting, a player must post scores totaling 54 holes in the current season.

Article XV There will be two separate winners for Gross Ringer score and Net Ringer score in each division.
